## ADMINISTRATION

Barnabas Center, Inc., encompasses the facility located in Fernandina Beach, a satellite office in Hilliard, the “New To You” Resale Store, and the Samaritan Clinic: Medical and Dental. The agency functions through a Board of Directors and is administered by a small staff. At the heart of the organization is a devoted pool of volunteers that assist with day to day operations.

## OUR GOAL

To see that Nassau County families in distress and in need have shelter, food, and basic necessities. Often times, we do that by paying rent and/or utility bills. In some cases we assist with medical or dental treatment. The Barnabas food pantry collects and distributes donated food. The “New to You” resale store provides clothing and household goods to those that need them.

## SERVICE GUIDELINES

As a private, non-profit, social service agency, Barnabas Center, Inc. is funded by corporate, church, civic/private organizations and individual donations. Any resident from Nassau County may apply; however, financial assistance is based on income, need and individual situations. Barnabas takes great care in qualifying client need.

## CLIENT CHRONICLES

A single mother of four working two jobs could not afford dental care for a severely infected tooth. Barnabas found a dental surgeon to perform the procedure, paid for prescriptions and she was able to return to work!

An 18 year old girl contacted Barnabas after being abandoned by her mother. She had just graduated from high school with a Take Stock and Bright Future Scholarship. Barnabas arranged for temporary housing so she would have a place to stay while locating an apartment near her job and college.

Barnabas provided necessities for grandparents who had just inherited five grandchildren below the age of six. We also helped coordinate childcare and ongoing support during their transition.

In the Fiscal Year 07/08, Barnabas provided assistance to 2,933 adults and 2,185 children in the following capacity:

- Utility payment assistance for those facing final cut-off notice.
  - Electricity: \$59,522.00
  - Water: \$2,192.00
  - Propane: \$3,993.00
- Housing assistance with verified past due notice.
  - Rent/Mortgage: \$68,970.00
- Medical/Prescription assistance: \$22,136.00
- Adult dental care: \$23,560.00
- Vision assistance: \$3,359.00
- Special Projects and Services: \$3,038.00
- Food Pantry: over 63,000 lbs of food was dispensed.

In October of 2005, Barnabas established the Samaritan Medical Clinic; a free clinic staffed primarily by volunteers, including local medical professionals and office staff.

Qualifying, uninsured Nassau County adult residents receive urgent care medical consultation services.

The clinic serves as a walk-in facility, and is held every Tuesday and Thursday evening beginning at 5:00 p.m.



Barnabas has recognized the need to provide access for dental care to the uninsured, under-employed residents in Nassau County. As a result, The Samaritan Dental Clinic opened in August of 2007. This is the first clinic of its kind in the area.

Dental professionals volunteer their time and expertise to provide care for those who would otherwise be unable to afford treatment. Services include general dentistry in the form of x-rays, fillings and extractions. Appointments are required and can be made by calling the dental clinic.
